

Setting Up Your Account


Once you sign up for an account and verify your email address, you should be good to go! Be sure to check your spam folder if you don't see the email.

Navigating Proto Cloud

After logging in, you will see a menu on the left-hand side, including pages for **Content** and **Devices**.

Content

The Content page is where you will upload your content. Simply click the **“Add Content”** button to start uploading. You will then be guided step by step through uploading your content.




Once content is uploaded, you can **assign** content to any Proto device in your account by selecting the Options dropdown “...”

Assigning content will download that content to your Proto Device so it is ready to play. You must assign content to a Proto device in order to play it on that device.

Devices

The Devices Page is where you will connect and manage your Proto Devices. Once a Proto device is turned on, follow the steps on the screen to activate it. Keep in mind a Proto device can only be registered to one account at a time for now.



To add a new device, turn on your Proto Epic and follow the instructions on the screen, or click **“Connect Device.”**



Playing Content to a Device

Once you have connected your Proto device to your account and assigned content to it, you will be able to play content on that device from anywhere in the world!

Simply navigate to your Devices page and click on the device you want to play content on.



From there, you will see all the content **assigned** to that device. Click a piece of content to start playing it on your Proto.

A play bar will appear at the bottom of your screen, allowing you to pause or play. You can also close the playbar to stop playing the content.
